



AHT skills Photographic Competition rules: 2022

The hairdressing and beauty skills competitions are designed to allow learners to prepare and get feedback from UK skills judges which will benefit those wishing to enter 2022 UK skills competitions. The AHT skills competitions are based on the requirements for the passive photographic entry when registration opens for UK skills in 2022. All entries will be free of charge.

These competitions will enable learners through feedback to refine and improve their skills to be ready to submit their entries to UK skills.

Entries will be accepted from Monday 28th February to Friday 4th March 2022.

All entries will be judged by a panel of UK skills experts week beginning 7th March 2022. Winners will be notified via their college or training provider. All feedback will be issued to college or training provider who has submitted the entries.

Photographs should be sent digitally jpeg, (the number of photographs required for each competition must all be on one A4 word document)

AHT Hairdressing skills competitions

AHT long hair up style on a mannequin

4 photographs (front, back, left side and right side)

Competitors are required to produce a hair up style.

Competitors are required to create their chosen style on a mannequin and all the hair must be up.

Ornamentation MUST be used.

No additional hair is allowed.

All styling tools and styling products are allowed.

AHT long hair down style on a mannequin

4 photographs (front, back, left side and right side)

Competitors are required to create a fashion long design on a mannequin, all hair must be down.

Ornamentation may be used but is not compulsory.

All styling tools and styling products are allowed.

AHT Beauty skills competitions

AHT Commercial Gel polish with Nail Art

5 photographs (before, both hands, left hand, right hand, thumbs)

ONE HAND CRÈME RED (no shimmer or glitter polish), ONE HAND FRENCH (pink and white polish only)

*Competitors to produce a gel polish finish on **a model with natural nails.***

No props can be used, and both hands must be placed on a plain table for the photograph.

*All work must be **free hand only**. No transfers, or stencils to be used.*

Both hands must incorporate nail art on at least one finger, embellishments like gems stones may be added to adorn the nail art however, they must compliment the design well and not be used alone.

LED/UV lamps must be used to cure the nails.

The models natural nails must be devoid of any polish, overlays, or any nail enhancement products.

No Jewellery except a wedding band allowed.

Manufacturers application instructions must be followed.

AHT Fantasy Make-Up

4 photographs (front; eyes open, eyes closed, left side, right side, all photographs must show all areas)

THE FOLLOWING AREAS MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE DESIGN: FACE, NECK AND DECOLLETE.

Students to ensure the front areas including décolleté (chest), neck and face have elements of the design on them but do not have to be covered completely.

No templates or stencils must be used glitters, gems, and jewels can be used POST fantasy make-up as a finish but must not cover more than 10% of the areas.

Headdresses, hair pieces may be worn, NO bald caps.

All make up materials including false eyelashes can be used.

No pre prepared skin additions are allowed, no direct modelling applications and no latex.

Application method can be brush roller or sponge.

Spray colour should not be used on the skin but may be used on the hair. No airbrushing allowed.

Hand-held and other props and costume may be used to enhance unpainted areas of the body only.

Female models can wear any of the following: Skin toned bra without straps or skin toned bandeau top, male models if used can also wear a bandeau style top.
